

Emmanuel AWANA Clubs 2017-2018

Fees: to support the AWANA Clubs, we ask each Cubbie, Spark, and T&T clubber to pay a yearly registration fee. The registration fee is \$25 if received on or before September 3, 2017 and \$30 if received after September 3rd. This fee covers such items as the cost of seals, badges, lesson materials, trophies, ribbons, worker training, and shipping. The uniforms and books are required for a complete registration. Some of the optional supplies may include bags, backpacks, and/or music cd's. See the registration form for more details. Scholarships are available. We do not want the cost to prohibit your child from attending club.

Handbooks:

Cubbies: Cubbies will recite their assigned verse(s) to their leader on club night.

Sparks: Sparks should complete their book one section at a time in numerical order.

T&T: Truth and Training clubbers should complete their handbook in numerical order.

Note: The Gold and Silver review sections may be completed in any order after each discovery section is completed.

Clubbers must pass each section in one sitting, and may receive up to two helps per section from their leaders.

For Sparks and T&T to complete one handbook in an AWANA year, they should pass at least two sections per club night.

Uniforms: Uniforms should be purchased along with your child's handbook. See the AWANA registration form for more details. Once paid, each clubber will receive their book and uniform¹.

Parent Expectations:

- Depending on the need, parents may be asked to help for up to three Wednesday nights per semester. In most cases the parent will fill in where a substitute leader is needed.

¹ Uniforms will be withheld if payment has not been received in full.

Club Standards:

- Emmanuel AWANA Clubs will be held on Wednesday nights from 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm.
- Doors open to clubbers at 6:30 pm. Clubbers are expected to bring their handbook, be in uniform, and wear athletic shoes. Upon arrival, parents are requested to check-in at the AWANA table as important announcements may be given at that time. We ask that Cubbie parents escort their child to their club room. Sparks and T&T clubbers may check-in to their club rooms individually.
- Adult supervision is required for all clubbers in the gym before and after club. Cubbies and Sparks may not be upstairs without adult supervision. All clubbers are to be picked up promptly at 8:00 pm at their designated rooms by an adult (18 yrs. or older) that is listed on the completed registration form.
- Respectful language is always expected before, during, and after club.
- Care and respect should be shown for church property and other clubbers property.
- Pushing, shoving, and roughhousing are not allowed.
- AWANA workers are to be treated with respect, and be addressed as Mr., Mrs., or Miss.
- Chewing gum, candy, drinks, and toys should be left at home.
- After every activity, the Commanders or Leaders in charge will begin counting from one to five. By the time number five is reached, each clubber is expected to be waiting quietly for instructions for the next activity. In AWANA, leaders and clubbers are taught to respect the “five-count”.
- AWANA workers utilize the “three-count” for individuals not following club behavior standards. If a clubber receives three reprimands in one meeting, they will be sent home for the night with one warning and will only be allowed to return when they agree to follow club standards. Three warnings and the clubber will not be allowed to return and finish the club year. There is zero tolerance for clubbers who choose to slip away from club or out of the building. If a clubber chooses to disobey this standard, they will not be allowed back for the duration of the AWANA year.
- Uniforms and handbooks are distributed to clubbers after full payment has been received for these items.
- Sections must be passed by clubbers in one session. A maximum of two helps per section is allowed.
- Game time is a privilege. In cases of extreme disorderliness, the privilege may be revoked for a night by the Commanders.
